

Quality Summer Fun Camp Competition Guidelines

Entries are invited for the following events:

- Drawing competition
- Essay/ Article writing competition
- Short Video Making Competition
- Quality Quiz Competition

The theme for the Quality Summer Camp is "Let's make quality a habit". All the entries are to be based on this theme.

Guidelines for Drawing Competition:

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: Students from kindergarten to 9th grade.

- Students from kindergarten to 9th grade can participate in the competition.
- The art should be hand sketched/painted and A4/A3 sized sheets can be used.
- Captions/Quotes can be added in English/Hindi. Make sure that the text is clear and readable and should stand out visually.
- Textual description of not more than 10 words.
- Entry is to be submitted online.
- Participants will receive an email confirmation that the application "Submitted successfully".

Note:

- The art must be the original idea created by the participant and the content should focus on the theme. Evaluation will be based on the visual impact, originality, creativity and relevance to the theme.
- Before uploading the image, make sure that your details (Name, class, and school) are mentioned on the bottom right of the drawing sheet.
- Only one entry per student is allowed in each competition.

Guidelines for Essay Writing Competition:

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: Students from 3rd to 9th grade.

- The essay/article writing should be written around the theme
- The essay should be the original work of the student and it should not be copied from anywhere
- Word limit:
 - 200 words: For students from class 3rd to 5th.
 - 500 words: For students from class 6th and 7th.
 - 1000 words: For students from class 8th and 9th.

Please adhere to the word limit.

- Kindly highlight all the references mentioned in the essay
- The essay should be typed in the following font: Times New Roman, 12 size
- Kindly mention the details (Name, class, and school) at the end of the essay.
- Do not include any pictures.
- Upload docx, doc. pdf and file size is not more than 2 MB.

Guidelines for Short Video-Making Competition:

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: Students from KG to 9th grade.

- A short video (duration: 2- 3 minutes) to be submitted depicting a quality story/ life lesson.
- The video can be submitted by a single student or in a team (maximum 4 members).
- The students of one team should belong from the same school itself.
- The video should clearly depict a story or a lesson specifically related to the theme mentioned.
- The video can be recorded in English, Hindi, or both.
- The audio and video should be clear.

Note:

• Mention all the details correctly while uploading the video in the participation form.

Guidelines for Quality Quiz Competition:

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: Students from 1st to 9th grade.

- Quiz Competition will have questions based on their Class level:
 - For 1st to 3rd Grade: There will 15 questions.
 - For 4th to 6th Grade: There will 20 questions.
 - For 7th to 9th Grade: There will be 20 questions.
- Every student need to attempt all the questions based on their grade to qualify for the competition.
- Quiz will be time-based, certain time limit will be provided to complete the quiz.
- Students cannot skip any question.
- Questions will be in the form of multiple-choice or in the form of puzzles.
- Each student is permitted a single attempt to complete the quiz.
- It is advisable for students not to switch between windows during the quiz, as doing so may result in an immediate termination of the quiz

Note:

- Only one entry per student is allowed in each competition.
- Participation in the Competition is free of cost.

EVALUATION:

• The winning entries will be chosen by the QCI-NBQP secretariat. The submissions will be chosen based on creativity and originality.

NOTIFICATION TO THE WINNERS:

• Winners will be informed via email.

RECOGNITION TO THE WINNERS:

- Winning entries will be listed on the official website, social media platforms, and Quality India Magazine.
- Winners will also receive a commendation certificate and a hamper.
- Every participant will receive a digital certification of participation.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- The decision regarding winning entries will be final and binding. No requests for disclosure of the evaluation procedure or reconsideration of the results will be entertained.
- The participant warrants that they allow the contest organizers to publish their work in any manner they see fit.
- All entries become the property of QCI and will not be returned.
